SUBJECT: NCLB Report Card

Section 1111(h)(2) of the No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB) requires that each LEA that received Title I, Part A funding to disseminate specific LEA (district) and campus level data to (1) all LEA campuses, (2) parents of all enrolled students, and (3) to make the information widely available through public means such as posting on the Internet, distribution to the media, or distribution through public agencies.

1. The School Report Card distributed in the Fall of 2008 included assessment results in the aggregate and disaggregated by race, ethnicity, English proficiency, and economically disadvantaged: by performance level; showing two-year trend data for each subject and grade tested; with a comparison between annual objectives and actual performance for each student group; and including the percentage of each group of students not tested. Migrant student results for the School years 2006-2007 and 2007-2008:

06-07 Seventeen Students were tested: Writing 5 out of 5 Passed, Reading 16 out of 17 Passed, Math 17 out of 17 Passed, Social Studies 3 out of 3 Passed, and Science 5 out of 5 Passed.

07-08 Seven Students were tested: Writing 2 out of 2 Passed, Reading 6 out of 7 Passed, Math 6 out of 7 Passed, Social Studies 3 out of 3 Passed, and Science 4 out of 5 Passed.

2. The School Report Card distributed in the Fall of 2008 included graduation rates for secondary school students.
3. Roby CISD and all campuses met Adequate Yearly Progress requirements under No Child Left Behind for the 2007-2008 School Year.
4. There are no Title I schools in this district identified as in need of improvement.
5. The percentage of teachers in this district teaching with emergency or provisional credentials is 0%, and the percentage of classes in this district that are not taught by highly qualified teachers is 0%. Because this district is a single attendance district, a comparison between high- and low-poverty schools does not apply.
